<p><b>STRAIGHT PARTY VOTING</b></p> <p>a. A Straight Party vote is a vote for all candidates of that party in PARTISAN OFFICES. It is not necessary to mark individual candidates for PARTISAN OFFICES if you vote Straight Party.</p> <p>b. You may vote a Straight Party AND ALSO vote for a candidate of a different party in any individual office.</p> <p>c. In any multi-seat office, a Straight Party vote is a vote for ALL candidates of that party. If you individually vote for any candidate in a multi-seat office, you must also individually mark all other candidates in that office for whom you wish to vote in order for all votes for that office to be counted.</p> <p>d. If you do not vote a Straight Party below, you may vote by marking each office separately.</p> <p>e. A Straight Party vote does not include unaffiliated candidates, nonpartisan offices, issues or referenda.</p>
