- Food & Nutrition – Assistance with food stamps and local food resources.
- Housing & Home Repairs – Guidance on mortgage relief and repair options.
- Community Outreach – Connection to events, information, and aging services.

The program prioritizes individuals with the greatest need and is coordinated by Richmond County Aging Services.

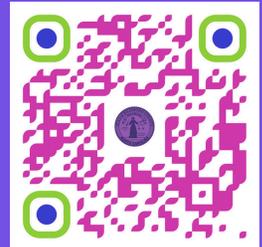
