**SICK >>> Shigella**  
**EMPLOYEES >>> E. coli**  
**HOME >>> Hepatitis A**  
**NOW >>> Norovirus**

Any associate displaying the following symptoms cannot work with or around food:

- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Sore Throat with a Fever
- Jaundice
- Unprotected & Infected Wounds


